



West Greeley Conservation District
Windbreak and Living Snow Fence Cost Share Program
Provisions and Applicant Certification

I would like to participate in West Greeley Conservation District's (WGCD) tree planting cost share program. I understand and agree to the following terms:

1. All land to be cost-shared must currently be on land within in the WGCD and must be a minimum of two acres.
2. Tree planting plans must be approved by the WGCD.
3. Fabric mulch must be used in planting.
4. At least two rows of trees must be planted, and preferably an additional row of shrubs.
5. The district will cost share 50 cents per linear foot of planting or 70 cents per linear foot if a drip irrigation system is installed. Anyone may plant the trees for the cooperators, but the cost share remains 50 or 70 cents per linear foot respectively depending on drip system. Drip system must be installed within first growing season for cost share eligibility.
6. The Landowner is responsible for planting and maintaining the trees.
7. Participant must own a minimum of 2 acres. Applications will be prioritized by the West Greeley Conservation District based on project merit and District goals.
8. The District will cost share a maximum of \$3500 per cooperator.
9. The District will not cost share if site is not properly prepared with at least one deep tillage.
10. Cooperator will be paid after planting has been completed and inspected by the District or NRCS and submits a copy of their SSN or Tax ID and an itemized bill.
11. Program cost share will not exceed 100% of cost when used in combination of other programs or insurance payments.
