

One West Greeley Conservation District's important goals is to protect our natural resources through conservation education and technical assistance. One of our educational programs emphasizes the conservation of water quality and quantity through the demonstration of our riparian trailer (representing the dynamics of a watershed), our EnviroScape (showing the causes and prevention of non-point source pollution) and our Ground Water Flow Model (a simulated cut-away section of the earth that allows for the demonstration of ground water principles). Each year we use this trailer at various water festivals across the local area.
