- 2. Camp Rocky July 5 thru July 11 Nourse will continue to seek campers and try to keep them within the district boundaries. We have five total scholarships available at \$350 each.
- 3. Envirothon May 14 & 15 in Alamosa Lowery will be and there will be 18 teams this year. Greeley West FFA is also participating and sponsored by WGCD for \$1,000.
- 4. **Children's Water Festival Conklin** attended and was a presenter for the Riparian trailer. He will also be attending festivals in Loveland and Ft Collins.
- 5. Houston Garden Conklin and Foose:
 - 4H Group Cloverbud May 30 there will be 60 4-H'ers
 - The Community Gardens has awarded Houston Gardens a \$500 grant
 - Quality Well replaced the pump and all is working well
 - Planting several perennials and plans to make signs to identify all plants

- 9. **Irrigation Pipeline NRCS** project **Mowery** presented some ideas with the idea of **WGCD** teaming up with **NRCS**. After discussion this topic will be tabled for a better time since NRCS did not get any funding for any irrigation projects.
